




Drinking water

81.1% of all household's main source of drinking water is classified as an improved water source. At the Union level it is lower at 69.5%.




Proportion of households with access to improved sources of drinking water, by State and Region



Childhood mortality

In Sagaing Region, 60 out of 1,000 infants die before their first birthday (Infant Mortality Rate IMR) which is slightly lower than the Union level IMR of 62.

Sanitation

71.6% of all households have toilets that are classified as improved sanitation facilities. At the Union level the figure is 74.3%.



Life expectancy

The Under-5 Mortality Rate for Sagaing is also slightly lower than the Union level rate of 72; 70 out of every 1,000 children die before reaching their fifth birthday.



A person in Sagaing Region lives on average until the age of 67.1 years, slightly higher than the Union life expectancy of 66.8 years.



Housing amenities

24.2% of households use electricity as their main source of energy for lighting; there are wide disparities between State/Region and urban and rural areas. At the Union level it is 32.4%.



81.8% of households use firewood as their main source of energy for cooking. At the Union level it is 69.2%.





Sagaing Region ranks fifth in population size compared with other States/Regions in the country.

Population density




Sagaing Region ranks ninth in population density when compared with other States/Regions in the country with 56.8 persons per Km.² The Union level population density is 76 persons per Km.²

Population composition





47.3% of the population are male and 52.7% are female.

Population Pyramid of Sagaing Region, 2014




The population pyramid for Sagaing Region in 2014 is pot-shaped; a similar shape to the population pyramid of the Union. This shape implies a declining proportion of children in the population and a bulge in the population aged 10-14 years.

Dependency Ratio

In Sagaing Region the Total Dependency Ratio was 53.5 in 2014. The dependency ratio measures the pressure on the productive population. The Total Dependency Ratio at the Union Level was 52.5 in 2014.




Literacy

Out of 3,598,969 people aged fifteen years and over, 3,372,855 reported that they were able to read and write. The literacy rate for Sagaing Region is 93.7%, higher than the Union literacy rate of 89.5%. Literacy rates are higher for males (96.6%) than females (91.4%).



School attendance

Out of 4,608,520 persons aged 5 years and above, and living in conventional households, 937,823 are currently in school.



Labour force participation rate

72.3% of all people who are of working age (15-64) were in the labour force. The proportion of males in the labour force is higher (87.5%) than females (59.1%).



Housing conditions

93.2% of households in Sagaing Region own their house.
